

Horsemanship Classes

Class #2 Western

Walk/Trot/Lope

- 1. Rider lead horse to the arena and stop in the middle. (Bridled)
- 2. Back up 3 steps.
- 3. Disengage hind quarters to the left 1/4 turn.
- 4. Disengage hind quarters to the right 1/4 turn and back to where you started.
- 5. Lead horse forward 3 steps and stop.
- 6. Mount horse, and wait 5 seconds. (Mounting block is available).
- 7. Immediately start a posting trot straight ahead.
- 8. At 3/4 of the arena, or across from the 2nd set of bleachers, turn to your right, then at the rail turn to your left.
- 9. Continue on the rail until you are at the centerline, then stop and backup 3 steps.
- 10. Immediately start your posting trot straight ahead.
- 11. Turn left and go down the long diagonal line, and in the middle of the arena change your diagonal.
- 12. At the corner turn right, and pick up right lead lope.
- 13. Continuing right lead on the rail, then at the centerline or the judges booth, turn right.
- 14. In the middle of the arena, lead change (flying or simple) to left lead.
- 15. Turn left at quarter line on your left lead lope.
- 16. At 3/4 mark of the arena, or 2nd set of bleachers, stop and roll back right.
- 17. On right lead lope head down the rail to corner.
- 18. Stop and back up 2 steps.
