



JHH Rules 2025

- Any person on show grounds must sign a liability waiver before unloading your horse.
- Any rider under 18 yrs old must wear a helmet.
- All riders and horses must wear numbers pinned on either side of the saddle blanket/pad and also on the back of the shirt.
- Anyone may school in any class, and must pay all entry fees. Rider must wear their number upside down and will not be judged.
- Horses may be ridden by multiple riders, as long as the appropriate number given to each rider is properly displayed on the horse.
- Any working and properly fitting English or Western saddle is allowed.
- A rider may be 2 handed only with an appropriate bit, such as a ring snaffle or even with a bosal. In the cowboy challenge course, it is permissible to change hands to work an obstacle. For any type of leverage bit, a rider must use an appropriate chin strap or curb chain. Split reins or romel reins are permissible.
- Tie-downs, martingales, and riding crops are allowed with proper use.
- Proper attire must be worn for all classes, which includes handlers for lead line. Western classes includes: long sleeve western shirt, belt, jeans, chinks or chaps are optional, cowboy boots, and cowboy hat or helmet if under 18. English classes include: long sleeve shirt or jacket, breeches, half chaps or boots, field boots and helmet if under 18. Absolutely no tank tops.
- Horses showing signs of lameness or illness may be removed from a class as determined by the judge.
- All decisions of each judge are final.
- Judges, staff and representatives shall be treated with courtesy, cooperation and respect.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct, inhumane treatment of any horse or person will not be tolerated.
- You will be asked to leave if you are not in compliance with any decision by judge, staff or representative.
