Horsemanship Classes

Class #3 English or Western

Walk/Trot

- 1. Ride lead horse (bridled) to the 1/4 mark of the arena or the 1st set of bleachers
- 2. Stop and back your horse up 3 steps, then make a full turn to the right and then a full turn to the left
- 3. Make a left and walk towards the mounting block
- 4. Mount your horse and wait 3 seconds before walking off
- 5. Make a right take 4 steps and then another sharp right and pick up a posting trot all the way to the rail
- 6. Make a left and continue a posting trot until you get to the udges Booth then make downward transition to walk another left and
- 7. Take 10 walking steps then pick up a posting trot before your figure 8
- 8. Make a figure 8 around the cones at a posting trot
- 9. After finishing the figure 8 make a left while in the middle of the arena and go all the way to the rail then make another left
- 10. Make a left at the 2nd set of bleachers and do a downwards transition to walk then stop
- 11. Back up 2 steps and start walking again
- 12. Once you get to the Judges Booth pick up a posting trot and then make a downward transition to a walk at the 1st set of bleachers
- 13. Make a right and walk towards your mounting block and stop.
